Santissima Trinità (ANNO B)

Il Nuovo Testamento fonda l'universalità della missione nello speciale rapporto che Gesù risorto ha con ogni uomo.

Il Vangelo dev'essere annunciato a ogni la volontà del Padre fino alla morte apprendo così per ogni uomo la via verso la pienezza della vita. Di qui le caratteristiche della missione:

- la forza che l'anima è lo Spirito Santo che da Gesù risorto viene promesso e trasmesso ai discepoli, come principio della vita nuova, che deve essere annunciata e comunicata a ogni uomo;

- il contenuto della missione è la sequela di Cristo, l'obbedienza al Vangelo, l'osservanza dei comandi di Gesù, l'adesione battesimale alla vita del Padre, del Figlio e dello Spirito Santo, il distacco dalla vita incredula, implorando e accogliendo la remissione dei peccati;

- la speranza che sostiene i missionari nelle fatiche e nelle difficoltà è la certezza che Gesù è sempre con loro sino alla fine del mondo (da Partenza da Emmaus, in "Rivista Diocesana Milanese", sett. 1983, 814-815).

The Gospel taken from the concluding scene in St. Matthew's Gospel (28:16-20), ends on what is perhaps the most explicitly Trinitarian note in the New Testament: the command to baptise "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." The risen Lord, having completed his mission on earth, claims "all authority in heaven and earth." Empowered with that authority the Church is to go to the nations of the world and "make disciples of them", communicating to them a sense of the outreach of divine love into the world, and the conquest of sin and death represented by the whole mission of Christ.

When people who respond positively to the Gospel receive baptism in the name of the Trinity they undergo an experience akin to that of Israel in the Exodus. Through the waters of baptism they become members of a people liberated from slavery to enjoy the privileged closeness to God described with reference to Israel in the First Reading but now immensely deepened through the intimacy gained in Christ. The "commandments" they are taught to observe flow from this relationship and give expression to it in everyday life.

All told, the scriptural offering for today's feast should communicate a dynamic sense of Christian life as a participation in the outgoing communion of love that is the Holy Trinity.
